Man: Did you take it with you?

Woman: I thought so. I went to the library to use a computer after lunch.

Man: It might be in the cafeteria. I'll help you search for it.

Question: What is the woman doing now?

Number 3

Woman: Are you ready to order?

Man: Yes. I would like to have the grilled fish and green vegetables.

Woman: Oh, I'm sorry. We don't have any fish this evening. Would you like to try our famous roast chicken instead? Man: Yes, please.

Woman: Would you like to change the green vegetables to French fries?

Man: That does sound good. I do want to be healthy though... Hmm...I'll keep the vegetables. Question: What is the man going to have for dinner?

Number 4

Woman: Are you ready to go?

Number 2

Opening your mouth wide like this (yawn sound) – this is called yawning. Today's class is going to be covering this common animal action. Now humans often yawn when they are bored or tired. Does this mean the same is true for animals when they do it? Well, that depends, based on the animals we are looking at.

Some animals yawn to scare away enemies from their home areas. Fish and lizards are perfect examples of animals that do this. They open their mouths very widely and stay that way for a long period of time.

Social animals, like chimpanzees or lions, yawn to decide who has the higher rank in their social groups. The animal with the biggest yawn is likely to be the leader of the group.

Now hippos are different – they use yawns when they want to make peace after a battle. Researchers have seen a pair of hippos yawn at each other for up to two hours before they both felt the fight was truly finished.

Sometimes animals yawn simply out of physical need— to increase oxygen levels. Interestingly, when they yawn for a reason like that, they act just like we humans do—they try to hide it by covering their mouths.
